Applicant:

- 1. Must be a teacher of reading (reading, exceptional student education, K-6 regular education) who has been teaching for less than three years.
- 2. Must be a member in good standing in the ILA, FLA, and a local council.
- 3. Must provide to the Administrative Committee Chairperson (Past President):
 - a. Completed application form (above).
 - b. Resume
 - c. Three letters of recommendation. These letters should be from:
 - (1) The teacher's peer teacher
 - (2) Principal (letter to include date of employment)
 - (3) Local council or special interest council President. In the event that there is no local or special interest council available within a reasonable driving distance, a letter from one of the following is acceptable: a department head, a grade level chair, a district personnel, another school administrator.

The FLA Committee shall make its recommendations to the FLA Board for approval with a maximum of one candidate per FLA district. Award winners shall be given a maximum of \$200.00 toward expenses for attending the Annual FLA Conference, a ticket to the Book and Author Luncheon and may receive complimentary conference registration.
