

Summary

"This dreamlike picture book asks the question: if you were night, what would you do? If you saw the moon tiptoe past your window, would you nestle under the covers? Or would you step outside to follow it? What if you felt a tail brush your ankle, would you freeze? Or skitter away? And if you saw an owl swoop from a branch, would you hide? Or join the hunt? Book Conversation

After reading the story aloud, you may use the following questions to prompt a book conversation with students.

- What are some ways we can describe what goes on at night using our 5 senses?
- What is this book teaching us about?
- What would you do if you were night?

Extension Activities

- 3. After reading the book, have students create a poem for what 'night' sees.
- 4. After reading the book, have students form groups to act out and create a scene of some of the things that happen at night.
